z/OS: From the Beginning.....

There are prerequisites for everything in life. We must crawl before we walk; practice before we play in the big game, etc. This rule holds true in information technology training.

The z/OS Fundamentals course is a two day high level overview of z/OS for the z/OS beginner. We explore the components that make up the operating system and how those components assist in getting our work into and out of the system.

The overview includes discussions of the z/OS hardware components, the software and the networking capabilities of the operating system.

For example, to use TSO/E for submitting a job, one might have questions such as: How do I logon to the system? What is JCL? How do I create JCL? What is a data set? After submitting the job to run, where can I find my results? Is there security involved? The z/OS Fundamentals class is ideal for answering these questions before electing to take the TSO/e class or the JCL class.

Other areas addressed are the internet capability of z/OS and what hardware runs the z/OS software. The networking capabilities are examined at a high level giving the student a heightened awareness of those capabilities.
